DA VINCI SURGICAL SYSTEM

Springfield Hospital's Center for Minimally Invasive Surgery features the world's most advanced surgical technology — the da Vinci Surgical System. The da Vinci's robotic

technology uses magnified 3D images to remotely guide tiny surgical tools with pinpoint accuracy. The system is especially beneficial in outcome and recovery time following: prostatectomy, fallopian tube reanastomosis, myomectomy, gynecologic tumor removal/staging and hysterectomy.

PULMONARY REHABILITATION

Pulmonary Rehabilitation helps people with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), asthma, emphysema, pulmonary fibrosis or other pulmonary diseases to improve their quality of life. Springfield Hospital's Pulmonary Rehabilitation Program uses closely supervised exercise training and education to reduce the risk of future problems. Cardiac monitoring is available for patients who also have a heart condition.

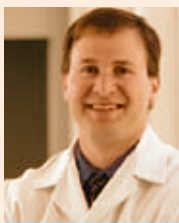

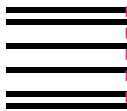

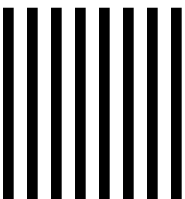
